Bullying and Harassment Policy



1. Purpose

Our club is committed to a sporting environment that is safe, respectful, and enjoyable. Bullying, harassment, discrimination and victimisation are prohibited. This policy sets expectations for behaviour, how to report concerns and how we manage complaints.

2. Scope

This policy applies to all members, competitors, officials, volunteers, contractors and spectators at clubs sanctioned activities and online channels.

3. Definitions

- Bullying: repeated, unreasonable behaviour creating a risk to health and safety.
- Harassment: unwelcomed conduct that offends, humiliates, or intimidates (including sexual harassment)
- Discrimination: less favourable treatment based on protected attributes.
- Cyberbullying. Adult cyber abuse: serious online threats, intimidation, harassment, or humiliation.

4. Standards of behaviour

All participants must treat others with dignity and respect, avoid gossip or exclusion, use social media responsibly and follow reasonable directions from officials.

5. Responsibilities

Committee: implement and promote this policy.

Any complaints should be forwarded to a committee member ASAP.
